SUPPORT FOR STRUGGLING SCHOOLS

During the 2018-2019 school year, the Department will continue to provide educators with tools and resources to support these priorities, and the specific work below to strengthen students' attainment of college and career readiness skills.

- Adopting and using high-quality curricula: Through a teacher-led, <u>curriculum review process</u>, Louisiana teachers, including <u>Content Leaders</u> and <u>Mentor Teachers</u>, have the tools they need to provide high-quality instructional coaching to all teachers and students across the state.
- Support for struggling students: The Department is committed to supporting struggling students, and helping teachers teach diverse learners through the use of the <a href="English learner">English learner</a> and <a href="Students">students</a> with disabilities</a> guidebooks, early and accurate identification of students with special needs, and better support for students in alternative settings.
- Supporting math and science instruction and assessments: In order to meet the needs of Louisiana's growing STEM industry, students will need to build stronger math and science skills through new <a href="STEM pathways">STEM pathways</a> and better aligned <a href="math and science assessments">math and science assessments</a> to measure their progress towards those skills.
