### 2019 Teacher Leader Summit



The <u>Teacher Leader Summit</u> is an annual learning event and celebration of Louisiana's educators. The summit is attended by teachers, principals, superintendents, and preparation provider faculty. Objectives include:

- Improve the everyday practice of educators in Louisiana by building their knowledge and skill in key areas related to their role
- Provide opportunities for educators to collaborate and share best practices
- Introduce high-quality resources and professional development that can be adopted and offered in schools and school systems across Louisiana
- Foster a culture that celebrates and engages educators and empowers and inspires them to take on an even greater leadership role within their classrooms, schools and school systems

# Faculty Attendance at Summit

"The things we require in our teacher preparation coursework are not always allowed when students enter the classroom and are required by their district to teach via Guidebooks."

"EPP programs need access to guided curriculum / materials. Faculty should also attend meetings with districts to understand how implementation of those materials."

"Yes, I think by providing us the same training as administrators for assessment of teachers and training on the new implementation of various curriculum. This would allow us to know how teachers are being assessed and trained and be able to provide that support based on research for our teacher candidates and residents."

## **Application Components**

The application for BESE approval of your Mentor or Content Leader training program will provide an opportunity for you to demonstrate that your training program is high quality, rigorous, and will prepare teachers to serve in these leadership roles. Through this application you must demonstrate that Mentors and Content Leaders are gaining the skills they need to effectively support other teachers.

The application includes three main sections:

- 1. Description of Training
- 2. Assessments
- 3. Program Evaluation

# On-site Review Workgroup

The on-site review workgroup, which will gather feedback from teacher preparation providers and school system leaders relative to how the on-site review framework can be strengthened, convened its first meeting on May 14. Twenty-three representatives from preparation providers and two school system leaders attended the meeting.

The workgroup will continue to meet monthly through this Fall to discuss revisions to the on-site review framework. The revised on-site review framework will be used to conduct on-site reviews beginning in 2020-2021.

### Performance Profiles

Performance Profiles will be shared with teacher preparation providers in summer 2019.

The Department will schedule an individual meeting with each preparation provider to discuss their profile(s) and answer any questions providers may have.

The Department will also offer a session at Teacher Leader Summit to collect additional feedback on the profiles.

### Formula Funds

Preparation providers who have undergraduate programs received formula funds for the third and final year in 2018-2019. As a reminder this allocation is made up of several funding sources.

The LDOE will continue paying a \$1,000 stipend to mentors of undergraduate residents.

If you received 8(g) funds as part of your formula allocation you must spend these funds by **June 15**, **2019**, and submit requests for reimbursement by **June 22**, **2019**. All federal fund allocations (IDEA, Title II, TIF) must be spent by **September 30**, **2019**. **Failure to meet these deadlines will result in a loss of these funds**.

# **Teacher Certification Updates**

The Department processes over 4,000 certification questions and applications per month. In order to better serve school systems, the Department recommends the following:

- Use <u>Teach LA Live!</u> to submit both applications and questions to the certification team
- While prep provider staff may contact the Certification Team at any time at <u>certification@la.gov</u>, they may schedule <u>office hours</u> in the online portal for a guaranteed time to discuss specific certification questions
  - o Please include name and contact number when scheduling

To increase efficiency, the Department stopped accepting paper applications on May 1.

### **Teacher Certification Renewal Process**

Most certificates are renewable for **calendar years**. However, the following certificates are issued for a **school session**:

- Practitioner Licenses (1, 2, and 3)
- Extended Endorsement Licenses
- Temporary Employment Permits
- Resident Teacher Certificates
- Out-of-Field Authority to Teach

These certificates are **not renewed** until **July 1** of each calendar year. For this reason, the Certification team will not begin processing issuance or renewal of these certificates until **July 1, 2019**.

Due to processing time, some certificates may show as lapsed or **expired** until they are processed by the Certification team. Once processed, they will show a retroactive **start date** of **July 1** and no lapse of certification.

### **Teacher Certification Renewal Process**

### Practitioner License (PL) Renewals:

- The **program provider** applies for PL renewal only if the teacher is enrolled in the Practitioner Teacher Program (PTP) on a PL1.
- The **employer** applies for the PL renewal when the teacher candidate is enrolled in the Certification-Only Program (PL2) or the Master's Alternative Program (PL3).

These certificates are renewed after July 1 each school year.
