

Family Math Engagement Grab \& Go: Geometry - Shapes

## Steps:

- Identify shapes within the environment.
- Shapes include squares, circles, triangles, rectangles, hexagons, cubes, cones, cylinders,
 and spheres. For example,
- The moon is a circle.
- The roof looks like a triangle.
- The door is a rectangle.


## Lagniappe:

- For children who are ready, children identify and draw triangles, quadrilaterals, pentagons, and hexagons. Talk to your children about the number of sides and angles in each shape.
