

## Family Math Engagement <br> Grab \& Go: Unit Rates

## Materials:

 the cost per item. For example: A store has beef steaks on sale for $\$ 11.97$ for 3 pounds of steak. Ask your child to calculate the cost per pound of steak.

## Lagniappe:

- Compare a sales price listed as a unit rate (ex. 4 items for $\$ 10$ ) vs. purchasing a single item (ex. 1 item for $\$ 2.25$ ). Which is the better deal?
