

## Family Math Engagement <br> Grab \& Go: Addition and Subtraction Practice

## Materials



- Paper
- Pencil
- Calculator (for the parent)

Steps:

1. Create addition and subtraction problems that utilize numbers up to 1000.
(a) Examples should incorporate numbers that utilize composition or decomposition of the tens and hundreds.
(b) Examples: $457+328=\quad, 724-258=$
2. Allow your child to solve the problems using any method.
3. Listen to your child's reasoning for his/her method of solving the problem.
4. Parents use the calculator to check your child's accuracy.

## Lagniappe:

- In upper elementary school, students develop fluency with addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division with multi-digit numbers.

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
