

Family Math Engagement Grab & Go: Addition and Subtraction Practice

This activity would be best used by: Schools Families



Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Calculator (for the parent)

Steps:

- 1. Create addition and subtraction problems that utilize numbers up to 1000.
 - (a) Examples should incorporate numbers that utilize composition or decomposition of the tens and hundreds.
 - (b) Examples: 457 + 328 = ,724 258 =
- 2. Allow your child to solve the problems using any method.
- 3. Listen to your child's reasoning for his/her method of solving the problem.
- 4. Parents use the calculator to check your child's accuracy.

Lagniappe:

• In upper elementary school, students develop fluency with addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division with multi-digit numbers.
