



CS Feedback Updates

- The Department continued direct outreach to the five parishes we had not heard from prior to the previous commission meeting. This resulted in responses being provided from one additional parish.
- Additionally, we shared the survey link with Mr. Faulk to attempt to reach these remaining four parishes.
- We are now representing feedback from 60 of the 64 parishes in the state, which equates to 94%.




Computer Science Education Advisory Commission Report

The Computer Science Education Advisory Commission Report includes the commission's recommendations addressing the requirements of Louisiana Act 541 (2022):


- Computer science state content standards for K-12
- Coordination of computer science education for K-16 and the workforce
- Graduation requirement, postsecondary entrance, and TOPS
- Standardized computer science teacher training
- Technical assistance grants for the creation and expansion of computer science courses
- Funding strategies for computer science teacher training and computer science expansion

Additional recommendations from the commission were also included.



Computer Science Education Advisory Commission

Louisiana Act 541 (2022), the Computer Science Education Act, establishes the Computer Science Education Advisory Commission to provide recommendations to the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education through the Department of Education for the development and implementation of a state action plan for the delivery of education in computer science in all public schools.




