She earned her Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education from Florida State University and her Master of Elementary Education with a focus on reading from Stephen F. Austin University. Altier believes that all students deserve to feel immensely loved in school and be excited by an engaging curriculum while having their learning tailored to their individual needs and interests. To that end, she has pursued grants to enrich not only her students' educational experiences but also the whole school community. With these grants, she brought life to a school garden focused on sustainable urban agriculture, created a mobile kitchen where students cook fresh vegetables they harvest, and designed a curriculum employing virtual reality headsets to boost experiential learning.
