




Louisiana Exemplary Educator Recognition Program

- This a confidential process. Candidates should not be aware of this recommendation.



Benefits to Candidates



If selected as an Exemplary Educator, the educator will receive the following:

- Certificate of Recognition
- Honored at a BESE meeting followed by a recognition reception
- Opportunity to attend specialized training for submitting proposals to present at the Teacher Leader Summit
- Recognition prior to the opening session of the Teacher Leader Summit/VIP attendance
- Possible invitations to participate on advisory boards and task forces
- Consideration for other state and national recognition programs







When candidates are named as Exemplary Educator honorees, school systems will have the opportunity to:

- Celebrate, honor and reward outstanding early- to mid-career educators for their hard work, dedication and success
- Honor educators who offer strong long-range potential for professional and policy leadership
- Call state-wide attention to the exceptional and innovative work taking place in their school/school system
- Recruit and retain outstanding educators




Timeline

PHASE	TIMELINE	DESCRIPTION
Recommendation Materials Release	October 17, 2023	The Department releases Exemplary Educator application materials for the 2023-2024 school year. Visit the resources library and Award's page.
Recommendation Portal Open	October 17 - December 15, 2023	Stakeholders submit recommendations for the 2024 Exemplary Educator Recognition in the online portal. online portal. This is a confidential process. Candidates should not be aware of this recommendation.
School System Reviews	January 2024	School systems will be notified of recommendations. School systems will review recommendations and indicate approval to move the candidate forward with consideration for the award. School systems will also have an opportunity to submit additional names of educators to recommend for the program.
Notification	Spring 2024	Educators selected for the 2024 Louisiana Exemplary Educator Recognition Program will be notified.
Recognition	October 2024	2024 Louisiana Exemplary Educators will be honored during a Louisiana State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) meeting followed by a recognition reception.




Criteria



Criteria

- Exceptional educational talent as evidenced by effective and innovative instructional practices and student learning results in the classroom and school;
- Exemplary educational accomplishments and leadership beyond the classroom that provide models of excellence for the profession;
- Individuals whose contributions to education are largely unheralded, yet worthy
 of the spotlight;
- Early- to mid-career educators (minimum of five years experience) who offer strong long-range potential for professional and policy leadership; and
- Engaging and inspiring presence that motivates and impacts students, colleagues and the community.



Recommendation Process




Recommendation Process

Stakeholders are invited to recommend candidates for the Exemplary Educator recognition program by submitting a recommendation in the <u>online portal</u>.

- The Exemplary Educator Recommendation Portal consists of the following:
 - Basic information
 - Responses to four written reflection questions
 - Evidence of student achievement gains
 - Awards received by the educator
 - Résumé (limit: two pages)
 - Additional uploads (optional)



Recommendation Process Tips


- "Cite evidence of student achievement gains as a result of the educator's practices"
 - Evidence may be from a previous year
 - May create bulleted list
- "Cite awards the educator has received"
 - May create bulleted list
- Resume
 - Do not ask candidate for their resume
 - You may create a simple resume as a bulleted list of employment history
- Please label documents uploaded accordingly, such as "Candidate's First Name_Last Name_ Name of Form". For example, "Mary_Smith_Resume".

School System Review Process

- School systems will receive an email along with a spreadsheet listing the educators recommended for the program.
- School systems will have the opportunity to review all recommendation information and will indicate approval to move the candidate forward with consideration for the award.
- School systems will also have an opportunity to submit additional names of educators to recommend for the program.
