Additionally, schools play a vital role in allowing students the opportunity for regular physical activity before, during, and after school. To recognize outstanding public elementary and secondary schools that are implementing an outstanding physical activity program, the Department will be recognizing and honoring exemplary schools through the School Physical Activity Award program.

An exemplary school for the School Physical Activity Award demonstrates physical activity throughout the day that includes:

- Physical Education Classes
- Physical Activity Before and After School
- Physical Activity During School Hours
- Family and Community Engagement Activities
- Staff Involvement
- Additional Exceptional Work

District and state-level application process:

- School systems may use this application or select their process for identifying their honorees to submit to the state-level competition. School systems using this application may streamline the process for their local-level competition.
- All application materials should be saved electronically for future reference.
- State-level applications are due in the online application portal by **Monday, December 9, 2024.**
- School systems will be notified when the state-level online application portal opens.

A complete <u>state-level</u> application includes:

- Basic applicant information
- Responses to the written reflection questions
- Parent or community testimony (letters of recognition) regarding involvement in your physical activity program
- An example of a "Success Story" of your physical activity program
- Candidate consent form
- <u>Student consent forms</u> (Needed for each student included in the application, such as in video/photos/etc.)
- Supplemental materials may be submitted to accompany the written responses and application. (Optional)
 - o These materials may be in any format, such as a chart, news article, video, photos, etc. Please label all materials accordingly to clearly reflect the task they are accompanying.
