3. Select from the list of materials referenced and available for review shown in Column 1 below.
4. View the available program by clicking on the link in Column 2. The User ID and Password, if required, are included in Column 3 and Column 4.
5. Public access to the materials is made available for four weeks. The Dates Open shown in Column 5 reflects the public access timeline.
6. Share comments by clicking on the “Submit Public Comment” link included in Column 6 and follow the rule and submission guidelines.
