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LOUISIANA FIRST-TIME COLLEGE FRESHMEN REPORT: FALL 2008 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The *Louisiana First-Time College Freshmen Report: Fall 2008* provides findings about the 2007-08 graduates who were enrolled as full-time first-time freshmen (FTF) in 33 Louisiana colleges/universities. A summary of data reported during the study of Fall 2008 FTF follows.

Graduates

- ❖ The total number of high school graduates in Louisiana increased from 41,906 in 2006-07 to 42,191 in 2007-08 (an increase of 283 graduates). Of the 2007-08 graduates, 82% were from public schools and 18% were from nonpublic schools.
- ❖ About 61.8% were White students, 33.6% were Black and 4.6% were other ethnicities.

College-Going Rates and Enrollment Data

- ❖ Of the 42,191 public and nonpublic school 2007-08 graduates, 50% (21,273) were enrolled as Fall 2008 FTF. The Fall 2007 college-going rate was 51%.
- ❖ From Fall 2007 to Fall 2008, college-going rates decreased for the FTF from public schools (47% to 46%), and nonpublic schools (70% to 68%).
- ❖ From the 2000-01 school year to the 2007-08 school year, first-time freshmen increased by 486.

- ❖ In Louisiana, FTF classes tend to have more female (57% in Fall 2008 and Fall 2007). Members of five ethnic subgroups enroll as FTF, but 69% of the 2008 and 2007 FTF were White students.

College-Readiness Measures

- ❖ The overall average American College Test (ACT) composite score for the 2008 graduating class increased from 20.1 in 2007 to 20.3 in 2008. Nationally, the overall average composite score decreased from 21.2 in 2007 to 21.1 in 2008.
- ❖ The Fall 2008 overall developmental rates decreased from 29% to 28% for FTF of public high schools. The overall developmental rate of FTF from nonpublic high schools decreased from 19% to 18%. The rate remained at 26% for the entire FTF class.
- ❖ Fall 2008 developmental enrollment rates for each subject area for the entire FTF class were as follows.

Reading 4.7%	Mathematics 20.4%
English 11.1%	Other 1.8%

Successful Completion

- ❖ The percentage of the entire FTF class in good academic standing at the end of the Fall term improved from 88% in Fall 2007 to 89% in Fall 2008.
