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AE Background and Context

Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) convened an AE Study Group in Spring 2017 to explore current practice and educational services provided in alternative schools and programs.

The Study Group charge was to:

- Conduct a strategic assessment
- Identify support services and guiding principles
- Explore partnerships



Alignment to State Statutes & ESSA

The guiding principles of the study group's report align to current state statutes for AE schools and programs:

- <u>R.S. 17:252</u> behavior and mental health interventions; data reporting
- <u>R.S. 17.416.2</u> academic, behavioral, and mental health interventions
- <u>R.S. 17:221.4</u> dropout prevention

The 2017 AE Study Group Report provided guiding principles for redesign.

AE Site Authorization Approval Implementation

A new authorization process was implemented in 2018-2019 and provided three years for all school systems to achieve full AE redesign implementation.

- Year 1 (2019-2020): BESE approved 10 pioneering AE sites under new authorization.
- Year 2 (2020-2021): BESE approved 6 AE sites under new authorization.
- Year 3 (2021-2022): All remaining AE schools and programs were to submit using the new process.
