As a reminder, at its March 2024 meeting, BESE approved updates to the Notice of Intent regarding Bulletin 741 Louisiana Handbook for School Administrators - §901 and §2347, focusing on policy surrounding FAFSA for 2024-2025 cohort graduates.

- LEAs must ensure that each student receives adequate support in completing and submitting an application for financial aid.
