

Financial Aid Planning

- It is a requirement for graduation for seniors to submit a FAFSA (if you want to apply for the federal Pell grant, federal student loans, the Louisiana GO Grant, and TOPS), fill out a TOPS application, or opt out and have a waiver on file.
- Assistance is available by phone, online, and in person.
- Louisiana is currently **4th in the nation** for FAFSA completions at 52%.


