

Sudden Cardiac Arrest Education

House Bill 400 (Act 385) of the 2022 Regular Legislative Session requires each public school nurse, coach, athletic trainer, and athletic director, whether employed or serving as a volunteer, to annually complete a sudden cardiac arrest education program.

The Department has partnered with Code Ana to provide this free <u>sudden cardiac</u> <u>arrest education course</u> that is available on the Department's <u>School Health</u> page for any school or person to access.

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Clean School Bus Program

The EPA has announced the availability of at least \$400 million in grants for cleaner school buses, reducing harmful pollution and protecting children's health. The grants will fund electric, propane, and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) buses that will produce either zero or low tailpipe emissions compared to older diesel predecessors.

Grant applications may be submitted at EPA's Clean School Bus Program webpage.

The Clean School Bus Grant Program will be open for 120 days and **close on Tuesday**, August 22.
