

EPA Clean School Bus

The EPA has announced the <u>2023 Clean School Bus (CSB) Rebate Program</u> and anticipates awarding at least **\$500 million** in rebate funding.

Eligible applicants can apply to receive funding for the purchase of up to 25 zero-emission (ZE) and/or clean school buses, along with ZE charging infrastructure and eligible workforce development costs.

EPA is prioritizing applications that will replace buses serving high-need local education agencies, rural areas, Tribal school districts funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and public school districts receiving basic support payments for students living on Tribal land.

Financial Aid Planning

All 2024 graduating seniors must complete one of the following:

- The <u>2024-2025 FAFSA</u> application (if you want to apply for the federal Pell grant, federal student loans, the Louisiana GO Grant, and TOPS)
- A <u>TOPS application</u> on the LOSFA website (if you want TOPS only)

or

• A waiver

The U.S. Department of Education is revamping the FAFSA application. The application will open in December 2023 instead of October 2023 (**this year only**).

Registered Apprenticeship Funding 2023-2024

- Funding based on the number of students enrolled in either fall or spring semester in an eligible registered apprenticeship course
- \$3,500 per student school system identified as rural by the United States Census Bureau
- \$2,500 per student school system identified as non-rural

Funding can be utilized to support all of the costs associated with delivery of the apprenticeship services to the students.

Proficiency by Exam/Portfolio

- Bulletin 741 §2314. Carnegie Credit and Credit Flexibility contains policy concerning student's earning proficiency credit by exam or portfolio
- Per policy school systems must <u>report</u> exams/portfolios used to award credit by proficiency
- Students may only earn credit by exam or portfolio in a course in which they have never been enrolled and received no formal instruction

TOPS University Diploma

- Foreign Language additions
 - <u>Computer Science as a Foreign Language Guidance</u>
 - For Fall grade 9 entry 2023-2024 graduating in 2026-2027 and thereafter

Jump Start TOPS Tech (Career Diploma) Requirements

- Geometry
 - For Fall grade 9 entry 2023-2024 and thereafter, Geometry is required. For grade 9 entry prior to 2023-2024, students must take three additional Math courses of which Geometry is an option.

2023 Legislative Updates

HB 103 (Act 267) - Adds financial Literacy as a required high school course.

At this time, BESE has not approved policy regarding Financial Literacy (Act 267). Once BESE approves the policy and it exits notice of intent, LDOE will release guidance.

The Academic Content team will create and release course guidance for the high school Financial Literacy Course. The Academic Content team processes submissions for a <u>Personal Financial Literacy Instruction Clearinghouse</u> pursuant to Louisiana state law (R.S. 17:270), in order to support local school systems with implementation.

Jump Start 2.0 Enhancements

The window to request enhancements for Jump Start 2.0 is open and will close on **October 30 at 11:59 p.m.**

Jump Start enhancements are based on recommendations made by CTE supervisors and approved by the Jump Start 2.0 Review Committee and BESE.

U.S. Presidential Scholar Program

The <u>U.S. Presidential Scholars Program</u> was established to recognize and honor some of our nation's most distinguished graduating high school students selected on the basis of outstanding scholarship.

In order to recommend students for nomination to the program, school systems are required to submit to the LDOE a <u>parental release</u> form for each nominated student and complete a <u>JotForm application</u> for each student by **4 p.m. November 6**. It is recommended that school systems review the <u>LDOE evaluation rubric</u> prior to nominating students.

This award shows recognition to schools that show a major commitment to serving students and families connected to the United States Armed Forces.

To earn the recognition, schools shall engage in the following activities:

- Designate a staff member to serve as a military liaison and engage in the following:
- Serve as the primary point of contact for military connected students and families
- Work to identify special considerations needed by military-connected students and families
- Develop training to inform teachers and other school personnel of those special considerations
- Create a dedicated page on its website featuring resources for military-connected students and families
- Create a student-led transition program to provide peer support for military-connected students
