

AED Registration Reminder

R.S. 40:1137.3 was updated in 2023 and now requires AEDs on site at ALL school campuses. The Bureau of Emergency Management Services (BEMS) has emailed schools to register AEDs with the Bureau.

Registration of AEDs is required and is available through BEMS for devices not yet registered.
