


#### 2021-2022 SURVEY RESULTS


## **Quarterly Enrollment**

Quarter 4 reporting for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (SEE) is May 1-3.





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

## Application

- In order to be eligible for an award, students must meet the following criteria:
  - a. Have an exceptionality of autism, intellectual disability, brain injury, developmental delay, other health impairment, emotional disturbance, or specific learning disability.
  - b. Be evaluated by the local school district and have an IEP or a district-created service plan.
- Families were required to upload copies of the IEP or district-created service plan along with proof of residency during the completion of the application.

# Continuing students had to reapply in order to maintain their award for the upcoming school year.




