# BESE and Brumfield v. Dodd Pending Approvals



#### BESE and Brumfield v. Dodd Approvals

#### **Tuition Donation Credit Program (TDC)**

#### 2023 -2024 Participating Nonpublic Schools

**Note to Schools:** Students may apply for and be offered a scholarship from the Louisiana Scholarship Program, School Choice Program for Certain Students with Exceptionalities, and the Tuition Donation Credit Program.

However, they may only accept and use **one** of the scholarships.



## **Home Study Program**



#### **Background**

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) offers two types of Home Schooling programs.

#### **BESE Approved Home Study program**

A student who participates in a BESE Approved Home Study program is considered in attendance at a day school and in compliance with state compulsory attendance laws. The parents have complete control and responsibility for educating their child.

#### Nonpublic School Not Seeking State Approval

A Nonpublic School Not Seeking State Approval, also referred to as a "registered nonpublic school", has not met the criteria established by The Department Of Education for approval, nor does it seek state approval. The LDOE is not responsible for ensuring students meet compulsory attendance laws. Parents and providers assume complete responsibility for the student's education.

#### **Home Study Application**

- As stated in R.S. 17:236:1 and the LDOE BESE Approved Home Study Guidelines, a parent or legal guardian must submit an application to the LDOE to receive BESE Approval.
- Schools are not permitted to submit a home study application in lieu of a parent or legal guardian via email or mail.



## Re-admission from Home Study to a Nonpublic School

- Parents who choose to enter their children in Nonpublic schools after having been enrolled in a BESE Approved Home Study Program are responsible for all educational documentation and/or verification.
- Students entering a school system must comply with all school or district requirements.
- For admission or readmission procedures to a nonpublic school, contact the nonpublic school directly.

## Transitioning from Nonpublic Schools to a **BESE Approved Home Study**

- A school cannot refuse to let a parent withdraw their child from public school, but if a child between the ages of 5 and 18 (unless the child has graduated) is not enrolled in a public or nonpublic school or is not participating in a BESE Approved Home Study program for at least 180 days in the school year, then the parents of that child could be in violation of the Compulsory Attendance Law.
- Upon receipt of a home study approval letter, it is suggested, when possible, that families provide a copy to their prior school.

#### **Interest & Opportunity Survey**

- The Interest and Opportunity Survey will be going out to all nonpublic schools that participate in the scholarship program in the Spring of 2024.
- All scholarship schools are expected to participate and complete the survey in a timely manner.
- Please be on the lookout for upcoming webinars from the Assessment Team and the Nonpublic Team regarding completing the Interest and Opportunity Survey.

#### **LSP Sanctions**

- Sanction data will be released within the coming weeks for all participating LSP schools.
- Schools receiving a sanction will be contacted directly by the Office of School Choice.
- Please Note: If sanctioned, it may impact the number of new seats awarded to your school for the 2024-2025 LSP Application cycle.





#### **LSP Audit**

- The audit process for all schools participating in the Louisiana Scholarship Program (LSP) is underway.
- All schools should provide timely, informative materials and communications as necessary during the process.
- The audits are a statute requirement and each LSP school is required to participate.

#### **Quarter 2 Enrollment**



#### **Q2 Enrollment for all LSP Schools is:**

December 1 - 5

Stay on schedule to ensure payments are received prior to the Holidays.



## 2024-2025 Louisiana Scholarship Program Application



#### **Application Timeline**

- One statewide application for all families via the Louisiana Believes Website opens December 11.
  - The application will close on January 19.
  - Families must submit all required documentation by January 26.
- One timeline for application open and close date (Orleans and all parishes)
- Applications are no longer submitted via OneApp all applications must be submitted via the Louisiana Believes application website.



#### 2024-2025 LSP Income Verification

- A household is defined as all immediate family members (parents and minor siblings) that reside in the home. However, it may also include any extended family members and/or guardians that have legal custody or guardianship of the student.
- Income must be verified for all adults that are members of the household.
- A household may provide their 2022 Federal Tax Return to verify income at the time of application. However if awarded a scholarship, the household must provide a 2023 Federal Tax Return at the time of registration in the Spring to confirm eligibility.
- If a household uses check stubs to verify income, the check stub must be the last 4 consecutive check stubs (for the current year) within 60 days of the date of application.
