



Site Registration

Schools are responsible for the following actions as part of the registration process:

- Maintaining updated income and residency eligibility documentation for each student
- Collecting required registration forms from families
 - Parent waiver for special education services
 - Parent acknowledgements regarding Scholarship funds
 - Receipt of rules and regulations form
- Sharing the school handbook with families.
- Informing families of all school rules, regulations, and policies, and <u>have each family</u> <u>participating in the Scholarship program sign an acknowledgement of receipt of</u> <u>these rules.</u>





Transfer Requests

Scholarship students who wish to transfer to another participating school must accept the scholarship at the original awarded school.

- The transfer window for the 2023-2024 school will open on June 12.
- Families are required to submit a Transfer Request form to the Department signed by both the parent/guardian and a representative of the receiving school.
- If a student transfers without a completed transfer form and email approval from the Department, they may lose their Scholarship.
 - It is the school's responsibility to inform the family when the transfer has been approved.
- The transfer window for the 2023-2024 school year will temporarily close on July 18.






Decline Awards

Scholarship students who no longer wish to participate in the program must complete a declined award form.

- This form is NOT to be used for families requesting a transfer.
- Once a family declines the award, they will no longer be eligible to receive a scholarship for the remainder of the 2023-2024 school year.
- Once the award has been removed, it cannot be reinstated.
- The family must sign the form acknowledging
 - They are willingly choosing not to participate in the LSP program
 - They must reapply if they would like to be considered for any future scholarship awards
- A school representative must also sign the form acknowledging that they have informed the family of the stipulations of declining a scholarship award.







Important Reminders

Reminders

Quarter 4 reporting for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (SEE) and School Choice Program (SCS) is from May 1-3.

- If the enrollment reports are not submitted on time, it affects student enrollment counts and delays payments.
- All Quarterly Enrollment Reports must be submitted on time via the LEADS portal to receive payments on-time.
- If a student drops from your school, follow the drop procedures so that the student can be dropped from your roster.


Reminders

Site Registration for the 2023-2024 school year begins on April 24.

- Final Rosters will be available in the FTP on April 24.
- Award notifications will go out to families via letter and email on April 24.
- Families awarded to your school must accept or decline their award no later than
 May 26.
 - If a family does not complete site registration by **May 26**, they may lose the awarded scholarship.
- Site Registration ends on May 26.
- Final Rosters are due on the FTP by May 31.
