2024-2025 Nonpublic School Annual Enrollment Report

- All BESE approved nonpublic schools are required to complete their school's 2024-2025 annual enrollment report in Edlink starting August 1, 2024.
- A school leader at each nonpublic BESE approved school is responsible for entering the 2024-2025 annual enrollment numbers by grade, gender and ethnicity must have an Edlink account.



2024-2025 Nonpublic School Annual Enrollment Report

- Training on how to use Edlink and request the NPS School Manager role will be provided in the coming months.
- The last day to submit the 2024-2025 annual enrollment report is October 15, 2024.



2025-2026 BESE Application Migration to Edlink

- We are launching the 2025-2026 BESE application for all nonpublic schools seeking BESE approval in Edlink on August 1, 2024.
- Each individual/school leader responsible for renewing their school's BESE must have access to Edlink.
- All required documents must be uploaded in order to complete the application in its entirety.



2025-2026 BESE Application Migration to Edlink

- Jotform will <u>not</u> be used for the upcoming school year for the BESE application.
- Training will be provided on the utilization of Edlink in the coming months.
- The last day to submit the 2025-2026 BESE application is October 15.



2025-2026 Brumfield v. Dodd Application Migration to Edlink

- We are launching the 2025-2026 Brumfield v. Dodd application for all nonpublic schools seeking Brumfield v. Dodd approval in Edlink on August 1, 2024.
- Each individual/school leader responsible for renewing their school's Brumfield v. Dodd approval must have access to Edlink.

2024-2025 Application Timeline

The 2024-25 Louisiana Scholarship application opened on December 11, 2023.

- Access the online application available on the LDOE website, found <u>here</u>.
- All online applications must be complete by January 19, 2024.
- All income and residency verification is due by January 26, 2024.
- 2024-2025 award notifications from LDOE will be sent to families by April 22, 2024.
- If offered an award, families must claim the Scholarship award by registering at their matched school by **May 24, 2024.**

*Failure to meet these deadlines will result in the application being marked incomplete and/or the removal of the Scholarship award.





School Responsibilities

School Responsibilities

- Schools are not allowed to implement admissions criteria for Scholarship applicants.
- Schools may not discriminate against Students with Exceptionalities during the admissions process.
- Schools are required to accept the grade of the sending school for all students awarded a Scholarship.
- Students that were on the waiting list for this year but did not get placed must reapply.

For more information see **Bulletin 133**, Chapter 3.



School Responsibilities

- Participating schools must indicate student eligibility in LEADS for all students who have completed an application.
 - Eligibility documentation must be reviewed for new scholarship students.
 - Families must verify income and residency at the first choice scholarship school.
- Demand reports will be provided at the end of each week during the application cycle to each school.
 - The report lists students who have applied and listed your school as their first choice.
 - Review demand reports provided by the LDOE throughout the application period.

The demand report does not guarantee that you will be awarded these students once the lottery process is complete.



Application Process

Application Process: Applicant Eligibility

<u>New Student</u> is any student applying to the Scholarship Program for the first time, who did not receive an LSP scholarship for the current 2023-2024 school year.

New students must be:

- A Louisiana resident
- Have a household income that does not exceed <u>250% of the federal poverty</u> guidelines
- Either entering kindergarten or enrolled in a public school with a C, D, or F grade on both October 1 and February 1 of the current 2023-2024 school year

Homeschool students and students in grades K-12 who currently attend nonpublic schools are not eligible.

Who Needs to Submit an Application?

- New students who are applying to the Scholarship Program for the first time
- Current Scholarship students in the highest grade at their current school
- Current Scholarship students who would like to transfer to another participating school

<u>Please Note</u>: Schools will collect all income and residency verification for new students during the application cycle. This information is kept on file for audit purposes.

<u>New Student</u> – any student applying to the Scholarship Program for the first time, who did not receive an LSP scholarship for the current 2023-2024 school year.



Different Types of Applications



Applicant Type	Description	Required Action(s) to be Considered for an Award
New Student	Any student applying to the Scholarship program for the first time in grades K-12.	 Complete a required application. Take eligibility documentation to the first choice school. Must meet income and residency criteria.
NSECD Student (NSECD students do not receive automatic placement into the Scholarship program)	A rising Pre-K 4 student who is applying to the Scholarship program for kindergarten.	 Complete a required application Take eligibility documentation to the first choice school. Must meet income and residency criteria.
"Terminal Grade" Student	Any current Scholarship student who is completing the final grade offered at their current Scholarship school.	 Students in terminal grades must complete a new Scholarship application for the upcoming school year. Those students who are in a terminal grade who fail to reapply will lose their Scholarship award. Students in terminal grades do not need to provide eligibility documentation to be considered for an award.
Continuing Scholarship Student	Any current Scholarship student who like to continue at the same Scholarship school the upcoming year.	 No application is needed. The student placement will automatically rollover to the current scholarship school for the upcoming year.
Continuing Scholarship Student (switching to a different school)	Any current Scholarship student who would like to transfer to another participating scholarship school for the upcoming year.	 Students must complete a new Scholarship application for the upcoming school year. Students do not need to provide eligibility documentation to be considered for an award.



Application Process: Income Verification

Parents and/or guardians must provide one of the following documents for every member of the household to verify their annual household income is below 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines:

If the parent participates in any one of the programs below, the parent can bring evidence that they participate in the program.

- Placement form from DCFS in the case of foster children
- Most recent unemployment compensation statement
- Louisiana Purchase Card (SNAP) Budget Sheet or Benefits Statement
 - The Louisiana Purchase card is NOT accepted as valid proof that the family is a SNAP participant.
- Most recent Social Security benefits statement



Application Process: Income Verification

If the parent does not participate in any of the programs previously listed, the parent will need to bring proof of income for every income-earning member of their household.

- 2022 Federal Tax Return, total income*
- Most recent pension statements
- Last 4 consecutive check stubs (for the current year) within 60 days of the date of application.
- Any income verification, benefits statement, or award letter from a government entity or tax-reporting business

*A household may provide their 2022 Federal Tax Return to verify income at the time of application. However if awarded a scholarship, the household MUST provide a 2023 Federal Tax Return at the time of registration in the Spring to confirm eligibility.

Application Process: Income Verification

- A household is defined as all immediate family members (parents and minor siblings) that reside in the home. However, it may also include any extended family members and/or guardians that have legal custody or guardianship of the student.
- Income must be verified for all adults that are members of the household.
- A household may provide their 2022 Federal Tax Return to verify income at the time of application. However if awarded a scholarship, the household MUST provide a 2023 Federal Tax Return at the time of registration in the Spring to confirm eligibility.
- If a household uses check stubs to verify income, the check stubs must be the last 4 consecutive check stubs (for the current year) within 60 days of the date of application.

2024-2025 Louisiana Scholarship Program Income Limits

Application Process: Residency Verification

Families must produce one of the following documents to verify their residency:

- Rental lease agreement or mortgage
- Electricity/Gas Bill
- Telephone Bill (Must be a landline-cellular phone bills will not suffice)
- Cable/Internet Service Bill
- Sewerage/Water Bill
- Current Official Letter from a Government Agency (e.g. DSS, DHH)
- Homestead Exemption Notice
- Property Tax Notice



Applicants must bring documentation to their first choice scholarship school for school staff to verify eligibility:

- 1. Login to LEADS (https://leads5.doe.louisiana.gov/ptl/)
- 2. Under the 'Student' tab, select the 'Apply' tab
- 3. Look up student application by entering the SSN
- 4. Select 'Submit'
- 5. Verify Student Information
- 6. Verify Parent Information
- Answer Eligibility Questions (Y/N)
- Select 'Submit'






- 1. Verify Student Information
 - Please ensure the student's SSN and date of birth are correct
 - Verify the student's physical address (No P. O. Boxes)
 - Select the student's assigned school district






- 2. Verify Student Information (Continued)
 - Please select the school that student is attending for the 2023-2024 school year
 - Failure to provide this information results in the application being marked incomplete in lottery



3. Verify Parent Information


- Make sure the parent's address on the application matches the verification provided
- If available, please verify the parent's email address and phone number
- Verify number of household members and income amounts listed on the application





- 4. Answer Eligibility Questions (Y/N)
 - This is where the school determines if the family meets the income requirements based on the income verification provided
 - b. Schools must answer all three questions listed
 - c. After answering the questions, hit "Submit" to complete the application

*Schools are NOT to select and/or change the school choices on behalf of the family. If the family needs to have this information changed, the family will need to contact the Office of School Choice.





Application Process: LEADS Verification

- Please emphasize to parents that eligibility must be verified after their application has been submitted.
 - The last day for families to submit eligibility documentation is January 26, 2024.
- As families provide their eligibility documentation, schools **MUST** complete the application verification in LEADS.
 - Please DO NOT WAIT until the deadline date to verify applications in LEADS.
 - The last day to verify applications in LEADS is January 31, 2024.
 - Applications cannot be updated to show eligibility after the January 31st deadline
- The LDOE will be monitoring applications (incomplete applications, non-verified applications, etc.) on a weekly basis.

<u>Please Note</u>: Being determined eligible for a scholarship, does not guarantee a Scholarship award.

Scholarship Awards: Match and Lottery

Once an application is submitted and deemed eligible, the application is entered into a lottery. Priority groups and random lottery numbers determine the order of awarding scholarships.

The Louisiana Department of Education will attempt to place as many applicants as possible in their preferred school choice.

- Not all applying students are eligible.
- Demand for some schools and/or grades is greater than availability.
- State funding determines final number of awards made.



Scholarship Awards: Match and Lottery

The Scholarship lottery process uses the following priorities (listed in order) to make student awards:

1.	Students transferring from a closing Scholarship school.	
2a.	Current Nonpublic School Early Childhood Development (NSECD) students, if applicable. This applies to students applying to the same school they attended while enrolled in NSECD.	
2b.	Current Scholarship student applicants that are in a terminal grade.	
3.	Siblings of current Scholarship students (In order to link students as siblings, all siblings must be listed on each application.) Only applies to children that are applying to a Scholarship school which their sibling already attends on a Scholarship.	
4.	Applicants attending a D or F public school or students transferring from a sanctioned Scholarship school.	
5.	Applicants attending a C school.	
6.	Applicants residing in the same parish as the school, if school chose to offer a geographic preference.	
7.	Current Scholarship students who wish to attend a different Scholarship school.	

While these students receive priority in the lottery process, a Scholarship award cannot be guaranteed.

Demand Reports

- Demand reports can ONLY be found by accessing the FTP.

- To login to the FTP please enter your username and password. <u>It is NOT the same</u> <u>username and password used for LEADS</u>

 - Enter your password for the FTP(this is password that you should have set yourself or by someone at your school)

Demand Reports

Demand reports are provided at the beginning of each week during the application cycle.

The report can be found in the "2024-25 LSP" folder

- The report includes the number of students who have applied and listed your school as their first choice
- There is a tab labeled "Incomplete Apps"
 - This is a list of applicants that have applied, but do not have a completed application because they have not provided eligibility documentation and/or have not been marked eligible in LEADs
- Please review demand reports provided by the LDOE weekly and make efforts to contact the families listed.

The demand report does not guarantee that you will be awarded these students once the lottery process is complete



Important Reminders

Quarter 3 Enrollment Report

- Quarterly enrollment is February 1-February 6.
- It is important that all schools complete their Quarter 3 enrollment by the deadline.
- Your enrollment for Quarter 3 will determine which continuing students are included/rolled over during the lottery for the 2024-25 LSP application cycle.
- Quarterly enrollment determines eligibility for roll over students.

****We will NOT extend the enrollment deadline beyond February 6.



Quarter 3 Enrollment Report

- All Quarterly Enrollment Reports must be submitted on time via the LEADS portal in order to receive payments on-time.
- If the enrollment reports are not submitted on time, it affects your student enrollment counts and delays payments.
- Students must be reported on Q1 and Q3 enrollment report to be considered a roll over student when the upcoming school year awards are granted.
- If a student drops from your school, please follow the drop procedures so that the student can be dropped from your roster.
