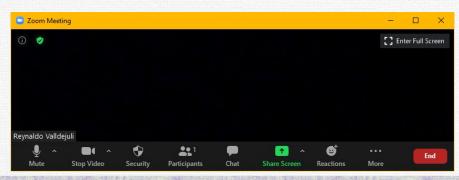

Grades 3 and 4 Summer Literacy Support

Students in grades 3 or 4 scoring below grade-level on the end-of-the-year LDOE approved literacy assessment shall receive explicit literacy intervention.

- 30 hours of explicit instruction inclusive of targeted literacy interventions
- School systems may use existing summer learning programs and structures that provide literacy instruction based on the science of reading.
- The <u>summer literacy Intervention guidance</u> provides information on eligibility, resources, schedules, and retention.

Approved Home Study & Nonpublic Schools Not Seeking State Approval: Reports & Reminders

- Monthly enrollment reports available to school systems via FTP
 - BESE-Approved Home Study Programs
 - Nonpublic School Not Seeking State Approval
- No documentation required for a parent/legal guardian to withdraw a child from public school
 - Nonpublic school not seeking state approval must provide a written notice of enrollment to the public school the student last attended
 - Parents may provide a copy of home study approval letter for the school's files upon receipt of the letter, but are not required to do so
