

<u>Act 99</u> (2023) provided for LEAs to issue a local permit allowing holders of associate degrees to serve as classroom teachers in a content area related to the degree.

Criteria:

- At least 25 years of age
- Continuously enrolled in a teacher preparation program
- Clear background check
- Provided with mentor teacher and weekly collaboration

Reduced Price Meals

HB1 (containing the appropriation for <u>House Bill 282</u>) was signed into law in June.

- Applies to the 2023-2024 school year and each subsequent year
- Students who qualify for reduced price meals by household size and income levels in the National School Lunch and Breakfast program will receive breakfast and lunch meals free of charge.
- LDOE will reimburse School Food Authorities \$0.30 per reduced price breakfast served and \$0.40 per reduced price lunch served.

- LDOE continuing the B-3 Seats pilot in 2023-24
 - Distributing additional funds to CNLAs that requested seats in the January 2023 Coordinated Funding Request.
- Pre-K CLASS[®] observations conducted for Early Childhood Accountability System will be completed using Pre-K-3rd CLASS[®] 2nd Edition starting in the 2023-24
 - Observers should complete Pre-K-3rd CLASS[®] 2nd Edition Transition training and Pre-K-3rd CLASS[®] 2nd Edition recertification testing prior to conducting observations.
- Community Network Lead Agencies (CNLAs) must complete Early Childhood Data Certification by August 18, to ensure informational metrics are accurately captured and reflected in Performance Profiles.


School Improvement: BOY Conversations

TOPS University Diploma: Foreign Language Additions

- <u>Computer Science as a Foreign Language Guidance</u>
- For fall grade 9 entry 2023-24 graduating in 2026-27 and thereafter

Jump Start TOPS Tech (Career Diploma) Requirements: Geometry

- For fall grade 9 entry 2023-24 and thereafter, geometry is required.
- For grade 9 entry prior to 2023-24, students must take three additional math courses of which geometry is an option.

- Parent or legal guardian must complete form to provide consent for the administration of corporal punishment during the current school year\

- All local school systems may receive applications for Type 1 and 3 charter schools.

 - Actions are required of <u>all</u> school systems.
