Academic Content

- Act 260 (2023) requires all grade 4-8 math teachers to engage in numeracy professional learning by August 2025.
 - Guidance is now available.
 - Training will released in the fall.
- All <u>Grade 6 Bayou Bridges social studies units</u> are now available. Additionally, Core Knowledge is now able to provide prices quotes for printed materials for all grade levels K-8.

Special Education Camera Maintenance Fund

- BESE approved <u>allocations</u> at its January meeting for additional funds to support maintenance costs related to cameras in certain special education settings described in legislation.
- Funds will be dispersed similar to the initial special education camera funds, and end-of-year reporting required in EGMS.



Early Childhood Care and Education

- The Spring 2024 CLASS® observation period has begun for early childhood classrooms at publicly-funded sites.
- Community Network Lead Agencies have started the Child Count process by working with sites to count all publicly-funded children served at each publicly-funded site as of February 1.
- Licensing reminders:
 - Public schools providing before and after care for children who have not reached age 4 by September 30 of the current school year must be licensed.
 - Early learning centers located in schools must ensure that children enrolled in the early learning center's care are not attending the unlicensed before and after school care provided by the school.

Educator Development

- Teacher Leader Summit <u>Early Bird Registration</u> is open until February 2.
- TLS <u>presenter applications</u> are being accepted until February 2.
- Applications for the 2024-2025 Aspiring Principal Fellowship are being accepted until March 8.



Educator Evaluation

Key Improvements for Educator and Leader Evaluation include:

- Grounded in evidence-based practices that enhance teaching and leadership practices:
- A more fair and transparent process that includes multiple measures, supports self reflection, and gives teachers a voice;
- Better feedback for improvement and resources to support individual growth; and
- Stronger connections between evaluation and professional learning.

Educator Evaluation Learning Year Options

During the 2024-2025 learning year, school systems will be given the option to remain in the COMPASS evaluation system, or transition to the new evaluation rubrics and system. The options for 2024-2025 are:

- Use the new Louisiana Leader Rubric and Louisiana Educator Rubric.
- Use the COMPASS evaluation rubrics.
- 3. Submit a waiver request to use an alternate rubric.

The learning year will include the most extensive options for training and ongoing support through this summer and the school year.

Summer Evaluation Learning Year Training

Training for all system and school leaders and observers will take place this summer. The Leader and Educator Rubric and Evaluation Training Guidance provides details on the summer training.

Registration went live on January 31.


