

Instructions for Out-of-State Child Care CBC Request for Former Louisiana Residents



The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) has outlined instructions for out-of-state Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) Lead Agencies to request a Child Care Criminal Background Check (CCCBC) for a former Louisiana resident. The following CCCBC components are required for individuals that resided in Louisiana within the last five years:

- 1. The Louisiana criminal repository
- 2. Louisiana Sex Offender and Child Predator Registry;
- 3. Louisiana Child Abuse and Neglect Registry
- 1. For information on requesting the Louisiana criminal repository, please complete the <u>Out-of-State Authorization</u> <u>Form</u> for Louisiana Criminal History for Former Louisiana Residents.
