



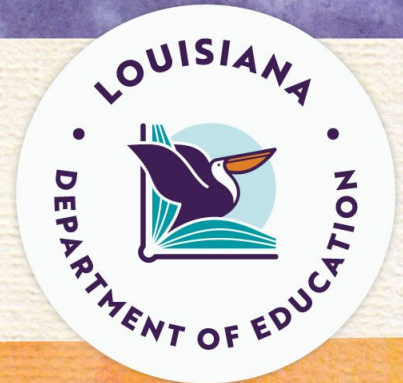

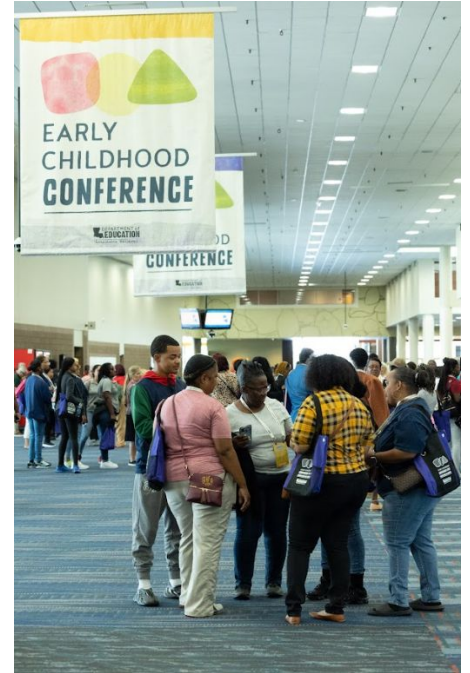


Registration

As an approved presenter, registration must be completed in the Whova app.

Your registration fee is waived. Requests to waive registration for one co-presenter must be sent via email to events@emergentmethod.com by August 23.

Your ticket grants you access to sessions taking place during the event and lunch.



Arrival and Check In

- **Parking**
 - Shreveport Convention Center has a [parking garage](#) with ample space at \$8 per day.
 - The Crowne Plaza in Baton Rouge has limited space. We recommend arriving early and carpooling when possible.



Arrival and Check In

- Presenters are responsible for loading and unloading their own materials.
- Presenters will check in at the counter labeled 'Help Desk' located in the lobby at the event check-in area.
- At check-in, each presenter will receive a lanyard with an event pass, t-shirt, and tote bag. T-shirt sizes will be determined based on the size listed at the time of registration.



Arrival and Check In

- Once event check-in has been completed, presenters should arrive to their designated meeting room 15 minutes before the session begins, whenever possible.
- Upon arrival to the designated meeting room, presenters should set up their equipment and test the presentation before attendees arrive.

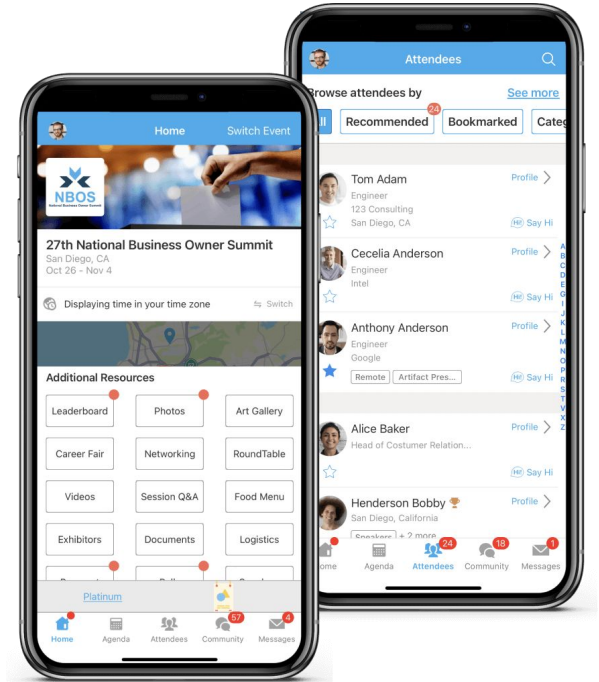


Session Materials

- The Early Childhood Conference is a paperless event. Presenters who choose to provide printed materials to attendees should bring them pre-printed.

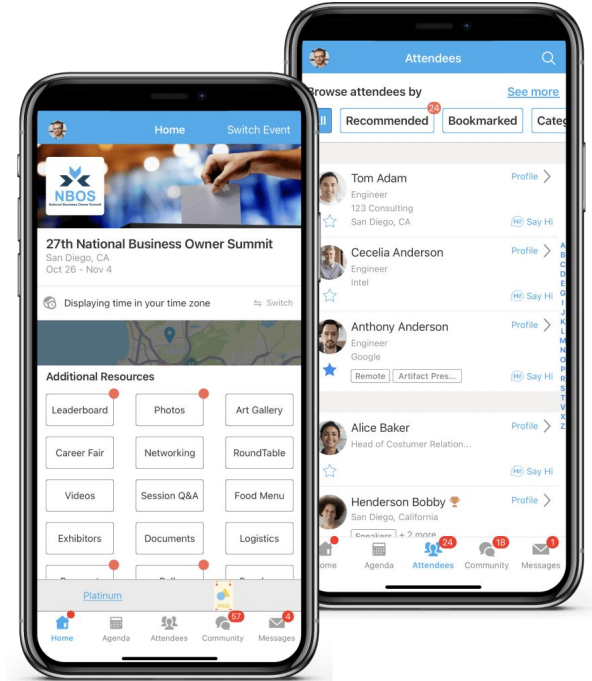
Whova
