

TEACHER/CHILD RATIOS



Bulletin 140 states that publicly-funded sites should maintain teachers/child ratios based on the age of children that are at or better than the minimum standards required in BESE <u>Bulletin 137</u> – The Louisiana Licensing Early Learning Center Licensing Standards.

To achieve three-star level ratios, publicly-funded sites use the following teacher/child ratios and group sizes:

THREE-STAR RATIOS

Birth to 1 year	1:4
1 year to 2 years	1:4
2 years to 3 years	1:6
3 years to 4 years	1:8
4 years to 5 years	1:10

To achieve two-star level ratios, publicly-funded sites use the following teacher/child ratios and group sizes:

TWO-STAR RATIOS



AGE	TEACHER/CHILD RATIOS
Birth to 1 year	1:4
1 year to 2 years	1:6
2 years to 3 years	1:8
3 years to 4 years	1:10
4 years to 5 years	1:12
