

Louisiana High School STEM Pathways Data Snapshot

The Louisiana High School STEM Pathways is currently being offered by 53 Louisiana school systems. From the STEM Pathway inception of the <u>Louisiana STEM Initiative</u> in 2018 through May of 2022, approximately 28,203 Louisiana students have taken a specialized Louisiana STEM Pathway course.

Statewide student access to and participation in high quality STEM Pathways has expanded to 58% of our state's parishes. Broadened access has been supported through the development of new high quality course offerings with well aligned teacher professional learning, new partnerships with Louisiana's academic institutions, and sustainable support from the <u>regional LaSTEM Centers</u>. Students who successfully complete four required courses from a STEM Pathway earn a Silver STEM Diploma Seal, and students who successfully complete the four required courses and four additional pathway courses earn a Gold STEM Diploma Seal.
