Equipping Literacy Leaders and Coaches: Long-Range Planning to Support Teacher and Student Needs

Session Descriptions:

Session 1: Structuring Your 6-12 Classroom for Learning Stations and Intervention: In this session, participants will determine how to set up learning stations in their ELA classroom, as well as how to drive intervention. There will be examples using HQIM of possible learning stations and how to determine what learning stations are needed. We will also look at which students require intervention and how to facilitate interventions.

Session 2: Planning Using your HQIM to Support All Learners: This session will guide participants through the unit unpacking process using a unit study tool. Participants will identify the supports included within their HQIM, using their data to identify students who should receive these supports, and plan for implementation for the appropriate group of students.

Session 3: How to Maximize Student Growth Through Data Cycle: In this session, participants will be guided in using the data from their curriculum-embedded assessments to maximize student growth. Participants will analyze the multiple data points within a curriculum to determine how the data cycles will inform their instruction.

Session 4: What Does Science of Reading Look Like Inside of Daily Instruction?: Participate in an interactive literacy lesson that engages participants in early literacy best practices that are grounded in the science of reading.

Session 5: Targeting the Skills from DIBELS Inside of Core Instruction: In this session, participants will identify the measures from the literacy screener inside of their core instruction program. Participants will also practice making adjustments to core instruction based on literacy screener results.

Session 6: Equipping Literacy Leaders and Coaches: Long-Range Planning to Support Teacher and Student Needs: In this session, participants will craft comprehensive long-range plans centered around building teacher capacity throughout the 2024-2025 school year. These plans will be carefully designed considering literacy data, high-quality instructional materials, and professional learning while considering teacher and student needs.
