



The Steve Carter Tutoring Program provides \$1,500 vouchers to families of eligible K-12 public school students per school year. The digital vouchers can be used to purchase high-quality literacy and math tutoring. The program is part of the Louisiana Tutoring Initiative and is named after the late Baton Rouge State Representative Steve Carter. Established in R.S. 17:4032.1 through [Act 415](#) of the 2021 Legislative Session, the program was expanded through [Act 649](#) of the 2024 Legislative Session.

- **Available to K-12 grade public school students** who are below reading and mathematics proficiency.
- **Tutoring sessions must be held after school hours**, in-person or virtually.
