- Scoring and annotating student work samples
- Developing and facilitating professional development sessions
- Participating in focus groups related to LDOE's academic strategy
- Delivering presentations related to updated social studies standards
- Authoring scope and sequence documents for updated social studies standards

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Any current Louisiana educator with 3+ years of experience is eligible; you do not need to be a school-site Teacher Leader to apply. We need educators who are passionate about ensuring that high-quality materials are available to Louisiana students and have...

- **3+ years of content experience,**
- **a desire for growth opportunities,**
- **deep understanding of content standards, and**
- **the capacity to devote time towards additional projects outside the normal work day.**

There is a **specific need** for expert educators in the areas of **early literacy, intervention specialist, Early Childhood (Birth to 3 and pre-K), and K-12 science and social studies**. We also need **K-12 teachers across ELA and math content areas**. **Special education teachers** who specialize in these areas are also encouraged to apply.
