SUBJECT: USDA Required School Lunch Match

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) requires an annual match of state funds for the school lunch program. The Louisiana Department of Education is provided a total state match amount by the USDA each year that must be divided into individual school system match amounts.

The attached schedule contains the required match amount by school system for **FY2023-2024**.

The methodology for calculating the school system match amounts includes a special School Lunch Match data set. This data set is a subset of the February 1 Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) Economically Disadvantaged (ED) student count data for each school system. The School Lunch Match data includes Free & Reduced Lunch Counts for all schools regardless of CEP status. The School Lunch Match data for each school system is applied to the State total match amount to determine the required match contribution.

Compliance by each school system with the match amounts is evidenced through the Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) funds identified in the Annual Financial Report (AFR). As such, the required match amount must be reported in the Annual Financial Report (AFR) at the end of the fiscal year in the revenue keypunch code 4450, State Public School Fund (MFP) – School.
