# Act 260 Numeracy Training Updates

In accordance with <u>Act 260</u>, the LDOE has created a full suite of Numeracy Professional Learning courses for K-12 math teachers. The LDOE plans to release the first five modules for each Numeracy course this summer. For educators to access the courses within the <u>Canopy Professional Learning Platform</u>, superintendents must have opted-in through EdLink Security to grant all classroom teachers a role in Canopy. Once this step is completed, teachers and staff should follow the steps below to <u>create an EdLink Security account</u>.
