To recognize outstanding public elementary and secondary schools implementing an outstanding physical activity program, the Department will recognize and honor exemplary schools through the <u>School Physical Activity Award</u>.

January 5 through February 2 applications are being accepted for elementary and secondary public schools that are demonstrating a <u>comprehensive physical activity program</u> (CSPAP). A CSPAP is a multi-component approach by which school districts and schools use all opportunities for students to be physically active, meet the recommendations of physical activity each day, and develop the knowledge, skills, and confidence to be physically active for a lifetime. A CSPAP reflects strong coordination and synergy across all of the components: physical education as the foundation; physical activity before, during, and after school; staff involvement; and family and community engagement.

The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) has contracted with the National Institute for Excellence in Teaching (NIET) to assist with reimagining the Louisiana evaluation system based on research and best practice, along with developing resources to support professional learning. An evaluation survey for counselors will be published in January to gather feedback from counselors to inform decisions regarding the counselor evaluation process. **The link to the survey will be posted in the January 16 LDOE Weekly Newsletter**.

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### **FAFSA Frenzy Week**

LOSFA is hosting a statewide **FAFSA® Frenzy Week (Monday-Sunday), February 5-11, 2024**, and is inviting <u>postsecondary institutions</u> to host at least one FAFSA® Completion event during the week. Institutions will have the flexibility to host one event during this week or multiple events, depending on their availability.

High schools are encouraged to direct their students and parents to local sites to receive FAFSA® completion assistance. Returning and non-traditional students will also be encouraged to participate.

Under the new process, all contributors who are required to provide financial information on a FAFSA® form will need a StudentAid.gov (FSA ID) Account. This means neither students nor parents will be able to access the FAFSA® form until they have created a StudentAid.gov Account. It will take 1-3 days for the information to be confirmed by the Social Security Administration (SSA) before the StudentAid.gov account (FSA ID) can be used to complete the FAFSA® form.

To ensure that your students and their contributors are prepared to begin the 2024-2025 FAFSA®, please encourage them to create their StudentAid.gov Account prior to attending a FAFSA® completion event. You can also request an FSA ID workshop with LOSFA.

#### Proficiency by Exam/Portfolio

Bulletin 741 §2314. Carnegie Credit and Credit Flexibility contains a policy concerning student's earning proficiency credit by exam or portfolio.

- Per policy, school systems must report exams/portfolios used to award credit by proficiency
- Students may only earn credit by exam or portfolio in a course in which they have never been enrolled and received no formal instruction

Q: STS has been closed since October. What should I do now that it's open?

- The "Informed" Counselor

**A:** Since the most current student transcripts are in your local systems, it would be beneficial to review them for accuracy prior to the upload by your system Data Manager. 2023-2024 transcripts uploaded fulfill STS categories. Best practice is to ensure Spring schedules are correct based on students' STS Core Progress Reports.

Also, verify mid term (December) graduates are exited properly and have graduation dates in STS. As a reminder, a student without a graduation date in STS is NOT a Louisiana graduate.
