FAFSA for December 2023 Graduates and FAFSA Resources

Please share with school counselors and those responsible for FAFSA completion.

Per the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE), the 2023-2024 FAFSA® won't satisfy the graduation requirement for your mid year graduates. Due to the uncertainty of the 2024-2025 FAFSA® release date, it is recommended that students complete the <u>TOPS Online Application</u>, which also fulfills the graduation requirement.

All 2024 graduating seniors must complete one of the following:

- Complete <u>2024-2025 FAFSA</u> application (if you want to apply for the federal Pell grant, federal student loans, the Louisiana GO Grant, and TOPS)
- Fill out a TOPS application on the LOSFA website (if you want TOPS only)
- Submit an opt-out non participation form
- Complete and have a hardship waiver on file

The U.S. Department of Education is revamping the FAFSA application. The 2024-2025 application will **open in December 2023** instead of October 2023 (**this year only**).

2024-2025 FAFSA Roadmap

The 2024–2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) includes unprecedented changes to how students and families apply for federal student aid and how we determine eligibility, giving students a better and simpler experience with the FAFSA form. Improvements include a direct data exchange with the IRS for income data elements, a new "Who's My Parent?" wizard, and a single consolidated portal for all FAFSA help resources.

To help ensure that students and families—and the partners critical to getting student aid dollars into the hands of students—are best prepared for a successful <u>2024–2025 FAFSA cycle</u>, we have launched the <u>Better FAFSA Better Future Roadmap</u>. Please note that the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available in December 2023.

ASCA Webinar: Build School-Based College Preparation Supports: Hosting a FAFSA Completion Event

With FAFSA simplification, there are some key changes coming to the 2024–2025 form graduating seniors will need support navigating. The new form is being released in December 2023, and the National College Attainment Network (NCAN) can prepare you to help students and families complete the form. Get a line-by-line review of the new form, address updates to the FSA ID process for individuals without Social Security numbers. Review the FAFSA Submission Summary (formerly the Student Aid Report), and learn about resources and tools available from the U.S. Department of Education's Federal Student Aid office and NCAN. Hear recommendations for building FAFSA completion support into your school's college-going efforts.

SCA Spring Reporting

The portal will **close for spring reporting** on **January 22 at 5 p.m.** for enrollments with private providers and on March 11 for Public Higher Education providers.

Bulletin 741 §2314. Carnegie Credit and Credit Flexibility contains policy concerning student's earning proficiency credit by exam or portfolio.

- Per policy, school systems must report exams/portfolios used to award credit by proficiency
- Students may only earn credit by exam or portfolio in a course in which they have never been enrolled and received no formal instruction

Q & A With Counselor Connect!

Q: I am aware the FAFSA doesn't open until December. What would you recommend counselors do with early graduates (December) needing to complete FAFSA forms for graduation eligibility if the new forms are not opened at that time?

- The "Best Practices" Counselor

A: I would recommend early graduates complete the <u>TOPS application</u> to satisfy their graduation requirement. If the student plans to attend college and apply for federal aid, they can complete the FAFSA application when it opens.
