All 2024 graduating seniors must complete one of the following:


- Complete <u>2024-2025 FAFSA</u> application (if you want to apply for the federal Pell grant, federal student loans, the Louisiana GO Grant, and TOPS)
- Fill out a <u>TOPS application</u> on the LOSFA website(if you want TOPS only)
- Complete and have a waiver on file

The U.S. Department of Education is revamping the FAFSA application. The 2024-2025 application will **open in December 2023** instead of October 2023 (**this year only**).

2024-2025 FAFSA Roadmap

The 2024–2025 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) includes unprecedented changes to how students and families apply for federal student aid and how we determine eligibility, giving students a better and simpler experience with the FAFSA form. Improvements include a direct data exchange with the IRS for income data elements, a new "Who's My Parent?" wizard, and a single consolidated portal for all FAFSA help resources.



To help ensure that students and families—and the partners critical to getting student aid dollars into the hands of students—are best prepared for a successful <u>2024–2025 FAFSA cycle</u>, we have launched the <u>Better FAFSA Better Future Roadmap</u>. Please note that the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available in December 2023.

- Geometry
 - For Fall grade 9 entry 2023-2024 and thereafter, Geometry is required.
 - For grade 9 entry prior to 2023-2024, students must take three additional Math courses of which Geometry is an option.



- Students may only earn credit by exam or portfolio in a course in which they have never been enrolled and received no formal instruction


National Apprenticeship Week






School Health Service Provider of the Year Nominations




