Per Bulletin 741, beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, the school counselor must:

- 1. Finalize the individual graduation plan for each graduating senior;
- 2. Upload all academic records into the state student transcript system (STS); and
- 3. Post the student's graduation date <u>prior</u> to the awarding of a diploma.



 - For Fall grade 9 entry 2023-2024 graduating in 2026-2027 and thereafter

Jump Start TOPS Tech (Career Diploma) Requirements

- Geometry
 - For Fall grade 9 entry 2023-2024 and thereafter, Geometry is required.
 - For grade 9 entry prior to 2023-2024, students must take three additional Math courses of which Geometry is an option.






College Board Weekly Office Hours

The <u>SCA Portal</u> will reopen for spring enrollment reporting on November 20.





Q & A With COunselor COnnect!

Q: In the May Counselor Connect, you mentioned pulling the STS Export Summary to Excel report as verification of the students with graduation dates in STS. Are there any other reports I should save?


- The "Best Practices" Counselor

A: To ensure you have the most updated records for your graduates, I would suggest in addition to the Export Summary to Excel report, you save a copy of your 2022-2023 graduates STS Core Progress Reports. The Core Progress Report traditionally displays as a one-pager for each student and shows the courses accepted in each category, as well as the FAFSA, Parental Consent, (GEE), and TOPS GPA. The STS Core Progress Reports can be accessed via the following steps:



Do I have all my STS graduation reports?





- 1. Hover over the "Print & Export" bar above the Student List
- 2. Click the "Core Progress Report" option
- 3. Click the arrow in the "See Report" column to the right of the TU gr 12 report
- 4. Click the "save" option (best output for this is PDF)
- 5. I suggest saving with the year and diploma type.
- Repeat steps with the other gr 12 reports TU = TOPS University diploma CA = JumpStart TOPS Tech Career diploma TC = TOPS calculation used in TU diploma pathway TJ = TOPS calculation used in CA diploma pathway

I also suggest following the same process <u>at the end of September</u> for grades T9-11 as STS traditionally closes from October 1 to late December/early January and is usually not accessible.
