 All school systems that tested students in June 2020 and/or who plan to test students during the October 2020 makeup for 2019-2020 juniors must sign the ACT MOU Addendum that is posted in the <u>Assessment Library</u>.

#### ACT State Administration

- October 6 and October 20 paper-based administration only for students who were juniors in 2019-2020 and were unable to test in March or June. The Department will cover the cost for one administration per applicable student.
- o Important: Materials will be shipped separately for each administration.
- o Currently, ACT does not offer remote administrations for any scheduled testing dates.
- o The Schedule of Events for the October ACT administration is posted on the ACT State Testing site.
- o The Schedule of Events for the 2020-2021 WorkKeys administration is posted on the ACT State Testing site.
- PearsonAccess next (PANext) is open through August 28 to manage participation and verify secure district shipping addresses for both the ACT October administration and the 2020-2021 WorkKeys assessments.
