# <u>System Open for Education Excellence Fund (EEF) 6/30 Periodic Expense Report (PER) Submissions</u>

Please share with business managers, EEF coordinators, school leaders, and school superintendents.

The eGMS system is open to begin submitting EEF 6/30 PERs. Schools or agencies that received a payment from the 2023-2024 Education Excellence Fund (EEF) this year should be advised of the following important dates:

- June 30: Deadline for EEF recipients to obligate EEF funds
- July 15: Deadline for EEF recipients to submit Final 6/30 PERs

Please be aware that Final PERs are used to calculate EEF allocations for the following year. If the Final PER is not submitted by July 15, EEF recipients may experience delays in accessing their EEF funds for 2024-2025.

**Important reminder**: When completing the PER, notice on the first tab (labeled Expenditure Obligation Summary) that there is a box at the bottom with a checkbox for Final Expenditure. Please check the tab, otherwise, PERs will not be reported as final and they will have to be corrected and resubmitted.

## **Bulletin 135 Update-Emergency Medications**

At its April meeting, BESE approved as a Notice of Intent a change that the requirement of an initial dose of emergency medications be administered by the student's parent/guardian outside the school jurisdiction with sufficient time for observation for adverse reactions.

The proposed policy change will read: Except in the case of emergency medications, the initial dose of a medication shall be administered by the student's parent/guardian outside the school jurisdiction with sufficient time for observation for adverse reactions.

## <u>Deadline Extended-Jump Start Construction Scholarship Application</u>

Please share with CTE supervisors, CTE teachers, and high school counselors.

The Louisiana Construction Education Foundation (LCEF), Louisiana's Community and Technical College System (LCTCS), and the Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) are now accepting <u>applications</u> for the Jump Start Construction Connect Scholars Program. This program is the state's first and only scholarship dedicated exclusively to Jump Start graduates who have earned a Jump Start credential and a Louisiana high school diploma. Subsequently, these students are enrolled in an LCTCS Construction Pathway Program or Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) training program the summer or fall immediately following graduation. This scholarship will assist graduates in gaining the necessary training to earn industry employment in construction crafts fields aligned to four and five-star jobs that may lead to management positions. The application deadline has been extended and is now due May 10.

Eligibility Requirements: Any high school senior with a National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) credential, will earn a Jump Start TOPS Tech Career Diploma and enroll in an LCTCS construction pathway program or an ABC training program in the summer or fall semester immediately following high school graduation. Scholarship Award: Up to forty one-time scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to students enrolling at an LCTCS program or an Associated Builders and Contractors training program.

#### **Educator Talent and Workforce**

#### CIS Evaluation Closeout for Teachers, Counselors, and Librarians

Please share with data managers, human resource directors, school leaders, and systems leaders.

Systems may begin finalizing teacher, counselor, and librarian evaluations in May. Systems are encouraged to complete and sign off on all observation and Student Learning Target (SLT) data prior to staff leaving for summer break. Once the deadline has passed for 2023-2024 data entry, no teacher, counselor, or librarian evaluation data can be added or amended. To create a streamlined process, it is recommended that educators complete the following assigned tasks:

#### **CIS Administrators:**

- Update rosters in CIS
- Assign evaluators to all educators
- Monitor evaluation completion in CIS

#### **Evaluators:**

- Ensure that all teachers, counselors, and librarians are in <u>CIS</u>
- <u>Enter</u> professional practice/observation scores in <u>CIS</u>
- Accept SLTs in CIS
- Rate SLTs in CIS
- Print observations and SLTs and meet with teachers, counselors, and librarians prior to leaving for summer

#### Teachers, Counselors, Librarians:

- Enter all SLTs in CIS
- Assess students and <u>report SLT</u> results in <u>CIS</u>
- Meet with evaluators to view and acknowledge observation and SLT scores

Systems utilizing spreadsheets to upload data to CIS should also finalize teacher, counselor, and librarian observations and SLTs in local system databases/trackers. The window to upload spreadsheets will open on May 6. Spreadsheets must be uploaded by August 1. Once the data is transferred to the new system in August, all data will be manually entered.
