New: Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Fiscal Requirements

Please share with business managers and financial managers.

Meeting yearly Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirements are part of the business process to confirm compliance and determine eligibility of federal grant funds for ESSA and IDEA grants. The USDOE requires an annual review that determines if each LEA: 1) has not decreased spending of general fund dollars, and 2) is budgeting expenditures to meet the MOE standards.

There are three MOE measurements submitted in the eGMS system, which will be available starting July 1:

- 2023 IDEA MOE Confirmation (Compliance)
- 2025 ESSA MOE Verification
- 2025 IDEA MOE Verification (Eligibility) submitted after the 2023 IDEA MOE Confirmation is marked Final in eGMS.

The MOE Quick Reference Guide is available to assist with those new to the MOE submission process. A Local Funds Only Calculator is available to assist in completing the Local Only Funds section of the IDEA MOEs.
