2024-2025 Annual RFA Charter Application-Overview Template

October 15 Deadline: 2024-2025 Nonpublic School Annual Reporting

The annual enrollment report window for all nonpublic schools approved by BESE (Private Schools Seeking State Approval) to submit their school's 2024-2025 annual enrollment data closes on October 15.

Prior to completing your school's NPS annual enrollment report, the school administrator who will be entering the accurate data is required to set up an EdLink account and request the "NPS School Manager Role." Please review and follow the request steps in the NPS Edlink Manual for the Annual Enrollment Report PDE.
