The Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) has launched Round 3 of the Charter Board Governance Program in an effort to provide consultancy, intervention, robust professional development, and collaborative mentoring opportunities designed to support school leaders and charter board member efficacy at no cost to Charter Boards. A LDOE-approved vendor will provide services.

The program has three pathways:

- Pathway 1 (Charter Board Collaboration-Mini Conference)
- Pathway 2 (Full Board Consultancy)
- Pathway 3 (Individual Board Member Capacity Building)

The Louisiana Construction Education Foundation (LCEF) Jump Start Construction Connect Scholars Program is accepting <u>applications</u> for up to forty one-time \$1,000 scholarships. The scholarship is geared toward students who have a Jump Start TOPS Tech Career Diploma, earned a National Center for Construction Education and Research credential, and plan to enroll in an LCTCS campus on a construction pathway or in an Associated Builders and Contractors training program.
