Opening of DCAI and ACT Data Certification

The Louisiana Data Review system is now open for certification of data used in the DCAI and ACT indices that will be calculated for 2023 school performance scores. This is the final opportunity for school systems to request changes to data. All requests must have documentation. Accountability contacts were provided with directions for secure access and resources to assist them and are responsible for sharing student-level school rosters with the schools. They will provide directions for how requests with documentation are collected in their districts. All submissions must be entered into La Data Review no later than **August 29**.

School System Financial Support

MFP Forward Funding

Please forward to Charter School business managers.

Charter schools may request MFP forward funding for significant increases in student enrollment from February 1, 2023 to October 1, 2023. Schools must demonstrate that the financial health of the school will be impacted if the student enrollment increase is not recognized with an adjustment the MFP monthly payments sooner than the March 2024 Mid-Year payment adjustments.

To apply for increased monthly payments for documented growth prior to the October 1 count, refer to the Charter School Library.
