As I visit with school and school system leadership across our state, I am very excited about our collective increased focus on mathematics instruction. We know our students deserve the very best, and our time committed to increasing effectiveness in math teaching and learning will yield improved student outcomes.



We know our teachers need resources and support to address the needs of all learners. We are proud to announce the release of <u>Foundational Lessons for Accelerating Math Education (FLAME)</u>. This new resource provides teachers with tools to build, track, and support the development of math fluency for students in grades K-5. FLAME offers engaging activities in the form of lessons to allow students to build the skills needed for success. FLAME is designed to complement any high-quality curriculum currently in place in schools. We acknowledge that curricular resources do contribute to students' fluency development. The missing element has been the ability for teachers to track and report the attainment of skills for each student.

The <u>public nominations portal</u> for the Outstanding School System Support Employee of the Year Award will close this **Friday**, **October 12**.

School systems will receive nomination information October 17. As a reminder, this information submitted by stakeholders serves as an extra layer of information for school systems to view/consider. However, systems are able to use their own processes to identify the candidates they'd like to participate in the state-level process. School systems that don't have a process in place may opt to select their honorees from the nominations pool.

On October 19, the <u>Outstanding School System Support Employee of the Year Application will open</u>. At that time, all application materials will be available on the <u>Awards page</u>.

School systems are encouraged to select up to three candidates, one per division (elementary, middle, and high) as their local-level honorees, and submit these selections to the state process. School systems without a formal selection process in place may elect to send their candidates directly to the state-level process. The deadline to submit school system-level applications is **November 30**.
