In my current role, I have the opportunity to guide and mentor teachers on their instructional practices to ensure students are learning each day. Although I miss having my own students and being a classroom teacher, I love getting to coach and support teachers, students, and families.

As a Teacher Leader Advisor, I had the opportunity to help develop the <u>Fluency Utilized to Engage Learners (FUEL)</u> materials that support ELA Guidebooks 3-5 (2022). These materials are an aligned resource for building students' fluency by providing fluency practice while keeping students engaged in texts from each <u>ELA Guidebooks unit</u> in grades 3-5. The FUEL supports include explicit teacher-facing directions for each activity with excerpts from the anchor and related texts to support diverse readers through targeted individualized support during small-group reading instruction.

One of my favorite things about FUEL resources is that they align perfectly with the curriculum and allow students multiple readings of complex grade-level passages while providing targeted fluency and phonics instruction. Another wonderful thing is that it is a one-stop shop for fluency practice; everything you need is included and designed to only take 10-12 minutes. In grades 3-5, students receive the final pieces of the foundational code and may need continued support in foundational areas, including phonics and fluency. FUEL supports not only meet these needs but they are also easy to use.

No matter what content you teach, all educators strive to provide students with a high-quality learning experience using the best materials. Using aligned resources is essential for providing our students with an instructionally cohesive learning experience. As Anita Archer says, "Teach the stuff and cut the fluff."

Energize Initiative Praxis (5652) Computer Science Content Exam Preparation for 6-12 Teachers

The <u>Energize Initiative</u> offers 40 hours of no-cost preparation to teachers in grades 6-12 for the Praxis (5652) Computer Science content exam. The Praxis (5652) Exam allows certified 6-12 teachers to add the Computer Science endorsement to their teaching license. The initiative is offered virtually, hybrid, and in person. The exam training will occur from January through June 2025.

Refresher eight-hour exam sessions will be offered for teachers who participated in Energize in 2024 and want additional exam review before attempting the Praxis (5652) exam. Teachers may register for the eight or 40-hour training through the online form.

EDUCATOR OPPORTUNITIES

Credential Clearance with a Criminal Background Check (CBC) for Certification

Effective January 1, Louisiana law (<u>R.S. 17:8.9</u>) requires criminal background checks (CBCs) for credentialing. This law is much more comprehensive than what has historically been in place where the CBC was requested and required for employment (<u>R.S. 17:15</u>).

A CBC will be required before a credential can be issued if LDOE does not have one on file less than five years old.

If a person has already been issued a credential before the implementation of this new law, and the LDOE does not have a cleared CBC for that person, the credentialed individual will be required to complete the CBC process at the time of applying for renewal, advancement, or modification.

Certification applications **submitted before January 1, 2025**, will be processed without sending the applicant to be fingerprinted.

For applications **submitted on and after January 1, 2025**, the applicant will check the <u>certification</u> <u>verification website</u> for a CBC on file with LDOE under five years old. If none exist in the applicant's LDOE file or if the applicant has no certification file, the applicant will be directed to the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet, where the individual will schedule fingerprinting with IdentoGO BEFORE certification can be processed. Certification applications are being updated with a new Professional Conduct form, the link to the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet, and other documents addressing certification clearance and how to determine if one exists or if the applicant will be subject to a new background check for certification.

Fingerprinting will be done at any one of the <u>IdentoGO locations</u>. IdentoGO provides a wide range of identity-related services with the primary service being the secure capture and transmission of electronic fingerprints for employment, certification, licensing, and other verification purposes. They will fingerprint applicants for Louisiana certification.

IdentoGO has assigned LDOE a specific agency "service code," which will be released with a waiver agreement and all disclosures when an applicant is directed to the CBC process after submitting the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet.

Fingerprint results are returned to the LDOE through the Louisiana Applicant Processing System (LAPS) with the CBC being transmitted within a few hours if the fingerprints are clear.

This new law requires a shared responsibility between BESE, LDOE, preparation providers, employing school systems, and certified individuals.

- BESE establishes policies for checks, including obtaining fingerprints and requesting information from state and federal bureaus.
- LDOE reviews the contents of the CBC before processing certification, making public any certification denial, suspension, and revocation.
- PREPARATION PROVIDERS assist teacher candidates in applying for the pre-service certificates informing them of the CBC requirement.
- EMPLOYING SCHOOL SYSTEMS notify LDOE upon the termination, resignation, or resignation in lieu of termination of any certified employee within 10 days of separation of service when the action results from a conviction for any felony or any offenses listed in R.S. 15:587.1.
- CERTIFIED INDIVIDUALS required to report criminal convictions to LDOE within two business days.
