

PURPOSE

In order to receive state and federal funding, nonpublic schools in Louisiana must be approved by the state Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) and be compliant with the nondiscrimination requirements of *Brumfield vs. Dodd*. The nonpublic school approval process is intended to confirm that schools utilize “a curriculum of quality at least equal to that prescribed for similar public schools,” as required by the Louisiana Constitution. Additional accountability measures apply for eligible nonpublic schools that participate in the Louisiana Scholarship Program.

APPLICANT CATEGORIES

Nonpublic schools seeking state approval will be organized into two categories:

- *Accredited schools*: Schools with independent accreditation from the [Southern Association of Colleges and Schools \(SACS\)](#), [AdvancEd](#), [Louisiana Montessori Association](#), or from an agency recognized by the [National Association of Independent Schools \(NAIS\)](#)
- *Non-accredited schools*: Schools without accreditation or with accreditation from an organization not listed above

A “returning applicant” is any nonpublic school with state approval for the prior school year (2021-22). A “new applicant” is any school seeking state approval for the first time or without approval for the prior school year.

All required documents must be submitted to the [Jotform](#) survey by October 30th, 2021 to be considered for BESE approval. Schools that complete all required documentation will be brought to BESE in December for approval.
