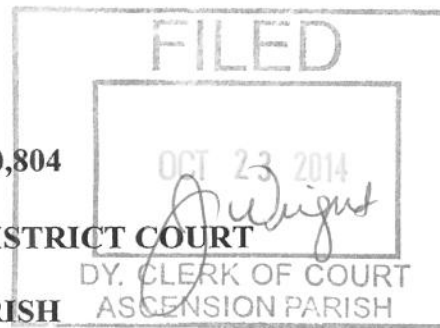

CONSENT ORDER

This matter was set for a hearing on the State's request for a preliminary injunction to block the operation of an alleged unlicensed child day care facility on September 26, 2014. At the hearing of the matter the parties reached an agreement, stipulating to the issuance of a consent order in the form requested, and stipulating that Yvette Imbraguglio has extended her cooperation to the Department in resolving this matter, and further stipulating that the Department waive pursuit of the statutory fines and penalties, contingent upon Defendant's future compliance with the terms of this Order.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED, that Yvette Imbraguglio, including her officers, agents, employees, representatives, and all others acting at her direction or on her behalf, shall not operate a child day care facility without first having obtained a valid, current license from the Department of Children and Family Services, all costs to be assessed against Defendant;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Defendant, Yvette Imbraguglio, cooperate fully with inspectors from the Department of Children and Family Services in verifying compliance with the terms of this Order, including but not limited to admitting said inspectors during all reasonable dates and hours for the purposes of verifying the number of children present and their relationship to Defendant at the facility.

That she has been served with the Petition in the above captioned matter;

That she is not currently operating a child day care facility as defined by LSA-R.S. 46:1403, in that she is providing care and supervision for fewer than seven children not related to her outside the presence of their parents and has no plans to provide care for seven or more children in the future;

That should she desire to provide care and supervision for more than seven children unrelated to her that she will obtain a valid, current license from the Department of Children and Family Services prior to doing so;

That she understands that no statutory fines or other penalties will be imposed so long as she complies with the terms of this consent order; and

That she freely and voluntarily consents to the issuance of this consent order, which requires her to obtain a child day care license should she wish to provide care and supervision to seven or more children other than her own children and grandchildren.
