- \* Holidays are projected based on known holidays and historical patterns. Additional declared holidays and changes in the projections could be accommodated. (LRS: 1:55-B, 2) Should the governor declare other holidays, you will be informed. Additionally, student, teacher and actual workdays will be adjusted as the calendar is adjusted.
- \* SSD Personnel Evaluation Program processes shall be reviewed with all staff during the 1st Grading Period. All documents required of employees are due to Regional Coordinators by August 1, 2012.
- \* Deviations from this calendar must be approved by the SSD Central Office a minimum of two weeks in advance of any proposed changes.
- \* Staff development/training activities may include regularly scheduled SSD professional development activities for teachers, and staff training required by the Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH), Office of Juvenile Justice (OJJ), and Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) facilities. Each school program is encouraged to plan at least one day per nine week grading period to conduct student-centered, educational/instructional activities, field trips, holiday-focused assemblies, etc.
- \* Thirty (30) hours of staff development may be scheduled throughout the year. This scheduled time may reduce the student day count up to five (5) days. These additional hours of professional development will be coordinated with and approved by facility administrators.
- \* This calendar is prepared based on twelve (12) month programming for students enrolled in facilities in which SSD provides educational services.
