Congratulations on an incredible Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System <u>release</u>! Since the shifts in 2017 to strengthen preparation programs and ensure alignment to Birth-grade 12 classrooms, your programs rated the highest since our accountability system has been in place.

- Overall domain scores and ratings improved in both pathways.
- Post-baccalaureate pathways are scoring higher than undergraduate.
- 78% of pathways increased their score or remained the same, and 85% of pathways increased their level or remained the same.
- Only 2 of 46 providers decreased a level.
- 52% of the pathways increased their domain score for Meeting Workforce Needs.

These <u>results</u> also reflect the commitment your faculty and staff have had in ensuring teachers are ready on day one of the job. This ultimately means a more effective workforce and better outcomes for our students. My team is looking forward to continuing to celebrate your success and support your efforts for continuous improvement.

Certification Reminders

New Applications. All certification applications have been revised and posted as of October 1. Effective **November 1**, all applications were required to be the October 1 version for processing. Effective **November 1**, applications will **no longer be placed on hold** waiting for evidence of payment. Any applications not including evidence of payment and/or accurate payment amount will be closed

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unprocessed.

Legal document

An educator's certificate is a public document owned by the educator. With the exception of the reasons listed in chapter 19 in <u>Bulletin 746</u> (criminal history, cheating, fraud, etc.), by decree of the governor, or as mandated by law, **all** changes to it must be **requested by the educator**, or in conjunction with a school system or teacher preparation provider.

The certification office **cannot** make changes to an educator's certificate without a request being formally made by the educator. That formal request must come in the form of an **application**.

Certification is **evidence-based**. The certification office can only determine eligibility based on the documentation provided or on file.

Application Minimum Requirements

Minimum requirements for a Certification Specialist to review/process an application:

- Currently accepted application version
- Fully completed (must actually make a request)
- Two forms of ID: Social Security Card (required) and Driver's License/State ID
- Fully completed professional conduct form
- All required signatures less than 90 days from date submitted
- Payment confirmation screen/email

This **does not** mean the request will be approved; only that it will be reviewed and processed.

90-Day Timeline

The certification office can only accept applications dated and signed within the last 90 days. Applications with signatures and dates beyond 90 days will be returned unprocessed.

Applications should be **complete** when submitted, however:

- Incomplete applications with one item missing will be declined, requesting missing information.
 - Missing item is submitted within 90 days of declination; no additional application or fee required. Unmet requirements are different from missing items.
 - Missing item is submitted more than 90 days from declination; a new application and processing fee required.
- Incomplete applications with more than one item missing, will be declined and will require a new application and processing fee be submitted.

There is a difference between unmet requirements and missing documents. Unmet requirements are any requirements not met before the application submission. Missing documents are for requirements met

Changing Portal Users

When adding or removing portal users, please use the authenticated user signature form.

- Complete fields electronically
- Physically sign the form

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- Upload to the online portal as an application type "Authorized Signatures"
- Within the notes of the submission case, indicate specific user access needs (added, removed, or updated access to TeachLA Live! and/or TeachLouisiana.net)
- Schedule an office hours call to discuss the changes

Office Hours Protocol

We ask that the following steps be followed to schedule an office hours call:

- Login to HR account in online teacher certification portal, <u>TeachLA Live!</u>
- Use the "Ask a Question" feature along the top ribbon of the page
- Choose "HR/Prep Provider Office Hours" in the drop down menu
- Indicate certification questions, cases, candidates and details around certification questions
- Submit the question case and receive case number
- Use online scheduler and indicate the "office hours" question case number in the reservation

Participants for this call should include individuals responsible for the implementation of certification policy in teacher preparation programs and school systems. April 2024 Program Approvals Full Application Now Open

Teacher, early childhood ancillary certificate program, educational leader proposals for initial approval, and mentor and content leader training proposals are accepted and considered by BESE twice per year. A panel of reviewers will evaluate proposals that meet all initial submission requirements to ensure they meet policy requirements. Applications that were submitted by December 10 are currently under review.

On-Site Review Updates

The Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System (TPQRS) includes Preparation Program Experience as one of the domains. An on-site review by a third party is conducted to understand the quality of the programs once at least every four years. There will be no on-site reviews this fall. The LDOE will be providing more details about the next cycle of on-site reviews soon.
